Application for a Schengen visa for the purpose of visiting family and/or friends

Documentation to be submitted

1. A completed and signed Schengen visa application form.
2. One passport-size photograph according to ICAO standards and not older than 3 months. If the photo is not up to standard it will be rejected.

1. Passport.

- Copy of the personal details page of the passport and the pages having entry/exit stamps on them.
- Copy of previously issued Schengen visas.

Please note:

- Your passport must be valid for at least 3 months from the date on which you leave the Schengen area.
 - It must have at least 2 empty visa pages.
 - It cannot have been issued more than 10 years ago.
1. Legal Permanent Resident Card or a valid US visa—valid at least 3 months beyond the date of return to the USA.
 2. Travel itinerary reservation (on your name).
 3. A hotel reservation confirmation (on your name), if you are staying at a hotel.
2. Documents proving you intend to visit family and/or friends.
For example:
 - A completed [formal obligation](#) (in conformity with article 4 of amended law of 29th August 2008 on free movement of persons and immigration) with legalized signature of the guarantor and validation stamp of the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs of Luxembourg.
 - or
 - Three recent bank statements, if you are paying for the visit yourself.
 - A Letter of Invitation from the host in Luxembourg accompanied by;
 - Luxembourg national: copy of the national identification card or Luxembourg Passport

- Third country national: copy of the passport, and copy of the residence permit – or stay authorization for a national of a EU Member State.
 - If relevant: proof of the nature of your relationship with the person you intend to visit, e.g. a birth or marriage certificate or certificate of registered partnership.)
3. Proof of health insurance, i.e. an official document from your insurer proving that:
- The insurance policy has been taken out in your name.
 - Your insurance is valid throughout the Schengen area and for the duration of your visit.
 - At least 30.000 EUR of medical costs are reimbursed.
 - Medical costs, including hospital care, emergency treatment and repatriation (including in the event of death) are covered.
- If your insurer will not provide an official document of this nature, you should take out travel insurance with appropriate medical cover for this trip with one that does.
4. Documents proving that you will return to your own country after your trip.
For example:
- A declaration from your employer, an employment contract or other information proving you are employed in your country of residence.
 - A document proving you are in education or training in your country of residence.
 - A document proving your children attend school in your country of residence.
 - A document proving you have a home or other immovable property in your country of residence.
5. If you are applying for a Schengen visa for a minor who will be travelling alone or with 1 parent, please submit the following documents:
- A copy of the minor's birth certificate.
 - A copy of an identity document bearing the parents' signature (1 document for each parent).
 - A declaration of consent from both parents, stating that the minor can travel.
 - If relevant: a court judgement stating which parent has been allocated parental responsibility for the minor.
 - If relevant: a declaration from the minor's school consenting to their absence.

IMPORTANT:

Additional documents can be requested in every case. Please be aware that if not all documents are submitted, processing of your application will be delayed.
