

Stay more than 90 days in Luxembourg:

A third-country national who wishes to travel/work/study or stay in Luxembourg for a period of **more than 3 months**, must follow a **two-step procedure**:

Step 1: before entering the country:

- submit an application for a **Temporary Stay Authorization**:

- hold a valid passport;
- if subject to visa requirements in order to enter Luxembourg, request a type D visa after having obtained the temporary authorization to stay;

Step 2: after entering the country:

- make a declaration of arrival in the new commune of residence in Luxembourg;
- undergo a medical check;
- submit an application for a residence permit.

Facilitated procedure:
